Term 3 Learning

This term sees year 2 undertaking Storyline. Our unit, *Time after Time*, will be taught across multiple learning areas. Children will be exploring how technology has changed their daily lives and comparing this to the lives of their parents, grandparents and others. We look forward to sharing our journey with you at the Learning Journey towards the end of this term.

In English, we will focus on:

- Exploring the structure and language features of narratives
- Engaging in stories from the past
- Continuing our Sounds Write learning.

In Mathematics, we will focus on:

- Money
- Number including place value and problem solving
- Chance and Probability
- Multiplication and Division
- Geometry skills - Flips, Slides and Turns.

We will also continue to provide a range of activities for children through Investigations. These activities will be planned and linked to all areas of our learning. This has been a great chance for children to develop their independent work habits and critical thinking skills as well as their ability to work cooperatively with their peers.

Year 2 will be looking at Protective Behaviours as a part of our social and emotional learning. This will explore feeling safe, taking risks, early warning signs, safe and unsafe touching and safety networks.

How you can support learning:

- Engaging in daily reading activities at home is a great way to build a love of reading. This also helps young readers listen to what experienced readers do.
- Playing board and card games to promote automaticity in our mathematics learning, turn taking and good sportsmanship.
- Promoting authentic writing experiences. Examples could include encouraging your child to keep a diary, or writing a letter to family members. Talk to them about their interests and help them write about these topics.
- As a family, discuss what changes in technology you have experienced over your life. Be ready for an interview about your own childhood experiences.
