## Unit Overview - Term 4 Year 5



### Term 4 Learning

Welcome to an unusual and exciting start to Term 4. This term we will be engaging in our inquiry unit based on Business and Economics with an emphasis on financial literacy.

*Student will investigate the following:*

- Why do I have to make choices as a consumer?
- What influences the decisions I make?
- What can I do to make informed decisions?

*Literacy activities will focus on:*

- Writing narrative texts
- Reading strategies, including examining primary and secondary sources.
- Spelling strategies
- Listening and viewing information related to Business and Economics.

*In additional to money, maths activities will focus on:*

- Prisms and Pyramids
- Angles Estimate, measure and compare angles using degrees.
- Grid reference (landmarks and grid reference)
- Describe translations, reflections and rotations of two-dimensional shapes.
- Apply the enlargement transformation to familiar two dimensional shapes
- We will communicate any remote learning timetables, expectations and assessment items through both email and in the Google Meets for students.

### How you can support learning

- Google Classroom for video links, related websites, learning tasks.
- Home reading support – please encourage at least 20 minutes reading a day.
- Exercise – walk and talk, bike ride
- Let's talk about our day – family members discuss their day
- What did I learn?
- What I enjoyed/made me happy?
- What could I improve on?
- Did I say or do something kind?
- What am I grateful for?

This discussion encourages children to understand their family members better, allows openings for world/local event discussions and strengthen family bonds. Ask students to explain their thinking – Why do they think that?
