## Kinder Overview- Term 2



### Term 2 Learning

This term we will be exploring the HPE unit 'Staying Healthy'. Student learning will focus on:

- Developing an understanding of how health information can be used in their lives
- Exploring ways students can make healthy choices
- Identifying the benefits of being physically active
- Observing and gathering skills

Each day our literacy block will focus on:

- The Sounds-Write program, with students continuing to learn to read and write sounds in a structured order.
- Participating in reading activities including sentence construction, viewing and listening to a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts.
- Developing writing skills including correct letter formation, recording sounds they hear in words, simple punctuation and reading back their own writing.
- Talk Time- Beginning in week 3- more information to follow.

Mathematics will focus on:

- Naming the number before and after a given number and counting to and from 20, from any starting point.
- Bonds to ten
- Building understanding of more than and less than
- Subitising a small number of objects
- Writing and identifying numerals to 20

### How you can support learning:

- Develop your understanding of the Sounds-Write program in an online information course for parents [here](#).
- Develop your child's love of reading by reading with, or to them in both their first language and/or English.
- Continue to read daily using the home readers and then ask your child to retell the story.
- Focus on the correct letter formation of lower case letters and using capital letters only at the beginning of names and sentences.
- Talk about the days of the week, the sequence of events and their time of day
- Identify numbers found in the environment such as on street signs, at the supermarket and counting or sorting household items.
- Develop oral language skills by playing card games and board games together.
- Involve your child in cooking and shopping
- Reinforce the Maths Norms in all areas of life: everyone can learn maths to the highest level, mistakes are valuable and questions are really important.
