Term 4 Learning

I will be adapting my music program to fit in with ACT COVID-19 regulations to keep our students as safe as possible in Term 4. We will sing and use instruments when we are told it is safe to do so.

This term we will focus on:

Kindergarten to Year 2 – learning to read and write music on the music staff, where and why people play music, beat/rhythm, improvising, deriving, notating (including graphic notation), composing, and performing their own piece of music.

Year 3LH/3HW – learning to read and write music on the music staff, deriving, and notating simple rhythmic patterns found in known song material, creating, and performing compositions, exploring the elements of music (e.g. rhythm, pitch, dynamics).

Small Group Classes - where and why people play music, beat/rhythm, improvising, creating, and performing compositions, exploring the elements of music.

Year 5 and 6 – Band students will continue to learn new pieces of music and theory at home. We are looking forward to rehearsing back together as soon as possible and preparing for future live performances. We cross our fingers that our year 6 band students will be able to have their end of year performance (Bandstravaganza) to celebrate their amazing band journey.

How you can support learning

- Go through your child's **Music Learning Journey** with them, from the end of term three, if you haven't had the chance yet.
- Ask your child to show you, the music activities they have participated in during home learning.
- Expose your child to a range of different music styles.
- Encourage your child to have a regular routine practice time for their band instrument.
