### Term 2 Learning

Our **Inquiry** unit *Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds* asks "How do I ensure I am thriving?" Students will interpret health messages and investigate how to stay active, healthy, and safe.

Our focus questions will be:

- Why is it important to eat healthily and stay active?
- How can I keep my body safe?
- Our can we remain safe online?

**Literacy** activities will focus on:

- Writing a procedure
- Writing a report
- Using knowledge of letter-sound relationships to spell words accurately.
- The reading skills of monitoring, predicting and inferring.

**Mathematics** activities will focus on:

- Fractions – halves, quarters, thirds, fifths and tenths
- Money – representing values in various ways and counting out change.
- Angles – Right, Acute, Obtuse and how they are found around us.
