Term 4 Learning

Welcome to Year 3 Bushtucker. This term our inquiry unit will focus on **democracy and decision making** in our society. Students will be investigating how people participate in their community as active citizens.

Our remote learning lessons will continue on Google Classroom as well as packs that have been distributed to families.

Literacy activities will focus on:

- Engaging narratives with curious twists and adventures
- Vocabulary building
- Word origins and investigations
- Sentence construction and creative writing opportunities
- Grammar

Mathematics activities will focus on:

- Money
- Fractions
- Mapping
- Whole number

Science

Our focus in Science will be on Earth and Space Sciences. We will investigate why we have night and day and collaborate through hands-on activities and research.

In the remote learning period the year 3 team actively promotes outdoor exercise and exploration - where safe and appropriate. The importance of gross motor skills is critical to maintain well being and overall health. Once we return to on-site, we will continue our daily run and gross motor skills.

How you can support learning at home and at school

- Create hands on learning investigation and experiences at home
- Read every day for at least 30mins
- Keep active - walk, cycle, run, stretch!
- Play simple number games and encourage mental computation e.g. adding multiple groceries at the shop and calculating the cost.
- Start a passion project at home - build something, draw, plant or research your favourite topic
- Read the time on a analogue clock
- Save your questions for the google meetings
- Reflect upon learning challenges and opportunities
